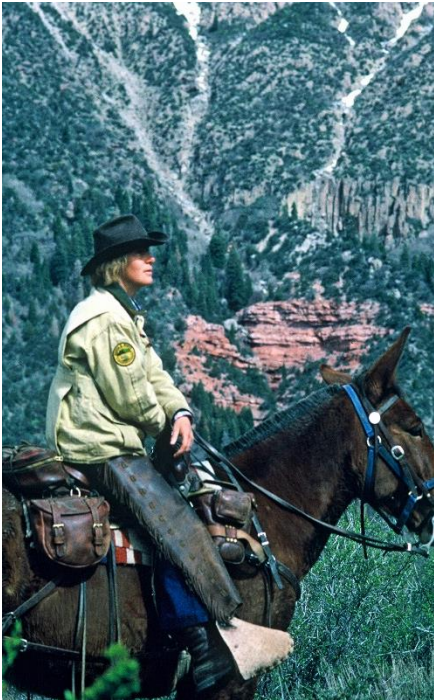

Learn to interpret and identify mammal tracks and signs in the field. We hope to find evidence of porcupine, fisher, bear, moose, and more. We will be looking for scat, browse and bark stripping, evidence of scent marking, as well as tracks themselves.
