1) Blubber

A layer of fat under the skin.

3) Gills

A part of the body that allows animals to breath underwater

5) Flippers

A part of the body that is used to swim through the water.

7) Mimicry

When an animal copies another animal's look.

9) Slime

Mucus that keeps an animal from drying out.

11) Shell

A hard outer part of the body that is used for protection.

2) Camouflage

Coloring that blends in with the Surrounding.

4) Migration

When animals move to a different habitat.

6) Sweating

Liquid that comes through the skin when hot.

8) Scales

Hard skin that protects an animal.

10) Webbed feet

Skin that attaches toes to one another.

12) Water Storage

An organism that keeps water in its body in a dry habitat
